*The goal of Christian Perfection
Christ should be manifest in our whole life.*

The life of the Christian has three distinguishing aspects: deeds, words and thought. Thought comes first, then words, since our words express openly the interior conclusions of the mind.

Finally, after thoughts and words, comes actions, for our deeds carry out what the mind has conceived. We must make sure that all our thoughts, words and deeds are being motivated by the revelation of Christ. For he has revealed himself to us. If we strive to know Christ Jesus, then all our words, deeds and thoughts will enter into a communion with the nobility of all that is implied in Christian perfection.

What then must we do to be found worthy of the name Christian? Each of us must first examine our thoughts, words and deeds, to see if they are directed toward Christ or away from him. We can place ourselves in check, so to speak. Are my thoughts, words and deeds in harmony with Christ or do they spring from the passions (are they motivated by my feelings)? If they bear the marks of being generated by passion then they bear the mark of the enemy of Christ, who smears the heart with the slime of passion, dimming and even destroying the luster of the precious stone of great price,

that great gift of your Faith, of which I spoke at length with you last week.

On the other hand, if we are free from and untainted by every passionate inclination, you are directed towards Christ in your thoughts, words and deeds. If you draw from him the thoughts of your mind, and the inclinations of your heart, then your actions, too, will show a likeness of his peace and love.

Christ inspires us to moderation and goodness in all our ways. This permits us to bear the name of Christ, and to truly call ourselves Christian, not only in name, but in our thoughts, our words and our deeds.
