**This coming Monday celebrates the feast day of Our Lady of Mount Carmel**

*In our Diocese, there are a number of Churches named after our Lady of Mount Carmel.*

The Carmelites have celebrated their patronal feast on this day since the 14<sup>th</sup> century. According to tradition, Saint Simon Stock was given the brown scapular by the Blessed Virgin on this day in 1251. The Order of Carmel dates back to a group of Western hermits who in the 12<sup>th</sup> century settled on Mount Carmel, overlooking the plain of Galilee, in imitation of the prophet Elijah (see 1 Kings 18.19-45 and 2 Kings 2.25). They grouped themselves around a small chapel dedicated to Our Lady. In the 13<sup>th</sup> century, the Order of Carmel as we know it was formed, retaining the twin devotions of the early hermits: to Elijah and his solitary prayer, and to Our Lady under the title 'of Mount Carmel.'
