The Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Celebrated every year on August 15, the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary commemorates the death of Mary and her bodily assumption into Heaven. This points to our own bodily resurrection at the end of time. Because it signifies the Blessed Virgin's passing into the glory of eternal life, it is one of the most important of all Marian feasts.

The Feast of the Assumption is one of the oldest holy days in the Catholic Church's calendar year, with recognition of this holy day going back to the sixth century. Catholics and Orthodox Christians in the Eastern Rite Traditions, refer to it as the Feast of the Dormition of the Theotokos, (the falling asleep of the Mother of God). The earliest printed reference to the belief that Mary's body was assumed into Heaven dates to the fourth century. The document is written in the voice of the Apostle John, to whom Christ on the Cross had entrusted the care of His mother. It recounts the death, the laying in the tomb, and the assumption of the Blessed Virgin into Heaven. Tradition variously places Mary's death at Jerusalem or at Ephesus, where John was living at the time.

On November 1, 1950, Pope Pius XII, exercising papal infallibility, declared in an Apostolic constitution known as the Munificentissimus Deus that it is a dogma of the Church "that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory." (Dogma means that it is an essential in our Faithful Catholic belief).
