Consecration of the Icon for Diocese of Peterborough

The Consecration of the Icon (“Vitae Aeternae Verba Habes.” – “You have the words of eternal life.”) will be held on Sunday, September 30, 2018 at the 10:30am Mass at the Cathedral of St. Peter-in-Chains. An icon (from the Greek word meaning “image”) is a depiction of a holy person or scene and icons are often called “windows of heaven”. The Icon for the Diocese of Peterborough is taken from the Gospel of John (Jn.6: 68). The iconographer is Marysia Kowalchuk from Madonna House in Combermere, Ont.
