**Pope Francis will Canonize Blessed Elisabeth of the Trinity** on Sunday, October 16<sup>th</sup>. The writings of this Carmelite mystic are well known and her spirituality is found to have many similarities to that of Saint Therese of Lisieux. Blessed Elisabeth was born Elisabeth Catez in 1880 near Bourges, France. She entered the Discalced Carmelite monastery in Dijon in 1901 and died five years later from Addison's Disease.
