**Our Lady of Lourdes**

February 11th, marks the first apparition of the Blessed Virgin Mary in 1858 to fourteen-year-old Marie Bernade (St. Bernadette) Soubirous. From February 11 to July 16, 1858, the Blessed Virgin appeared 18 times to St. Bernadette in the hollow of the rock at Lourdes. On March 25 she said to St. Bernadette: "I am the Immaculate Conception." Since then Lourdes has become a place of pilgrimage where many cures and conversions have taken place. The message of Lourdes is a call to personal conversion, prayer, and charity. The many miracles performed through the intercession of the Blessed Virgin at Lourdes prompted the Church to institute a special commemorative feast, the "Apparition of the Immaculate Virgin Mary."

**The World Day of the Sick** is a feast day of the Roman Catholic Church which was instituted in 1992 by Pope John Paul II. It is celebrated every year on the commemoration of Our Lady of Lourdes to offer up one's suffering; to pray for those suffering from illnesses and for those who care for them. The day coincides with the commemoration of Our Lady of Lourdes on February 11<sup>th</sup>.
