Pray-Give-Speak Out – An Interfaith Appeal from Canada’s Faith Communities

Faith leaders across Canada call upon parish communities and all Canadians to mobilize in response to one of the world’s largest humanitarian crises since the Second World War. In February 2017, a declaration of famine was made by, UN Secretary-General, Antonio Guterres, stating that 20 million people are at risk of death in the next six months in South Sudan, Somalia, Yemen and Nigeria. The famine crisis stems from a conjunction of events that include armed conflicts coupled with severe droughts brought about by climate change. Faith leaders are asking all people to take actions of Prayer; Giving and Speaking Out. **Pray** for the people affected during personal and community prayer. **Give** to the Famine Relief Fund created by the Canadian Government and they will match all donations until June 30, 2017. **Speak out** to your family, friends and Member of Parliament about your concerns and become better informed. There will be a collection for the Famine Relief Fund on the weekend of June 24/25.
