September 27th was the memorial of St. Vincent De Paul

He was born in Glascony in 1582. After completing his studies, he was ordained and went to Paris where he served in a Parish. He founded the Congregation to the Missions to supervise the formation of Priests and to give support to the poor. He died in Paris in 1660.

Since Christ willed to be born poor, he chose for himself disciples who were poor. He made himself the servant of the poor and to share their poverty. He went so far as to say that he would consider every deed which either helps or harms the poor as done for or against himself. Since

God surely loves the poor, he also loves those who love the poor. When one person holds another dear, he also includes in his affection anyone who loves or serves the one he loves. That is why we hope that God will love us for the sake of the poor. So when we visit the poor and needy, we try to understand where they are concerned. We sympathize with them so fully that we can echo Paul's words: "I have become all things to all men". Therefore, we must try to be stirred by our neighbours' worries and distress. We must beg God to pour into our hearts sentiments of pity and compassion and to fill them again and again with these dispositions.
